The Korean American University Professors Association (KAUPA) is excited to announce **students' research paper submissions** for the **2026 KAUPA 40**th **Anniversary Conference**. This conference provides a unique opportunity to present students' research work from multiple disciplines, focusing on the present and future of Korean studies in the Artificial Intelligence era. All Korean American students at undergraduate and graduate levels are welcome to submit their research studies. Student presenters can be from one of the five disciplinary categories: 1) Law, Liberal Arts, Humanities, Social Sciences, and Education, 2) Business, Finance, and Economics, 3) Engineering, 4) Science, and 5) Medicine and Public Health. Three students will be selected, and their travel costs will be fully covered up to \$1,000. Once selected, student presenters will present their papers during a digital poster session on the conferment day.

Topics

- Problem-solving with Artificial Intelligence in the Korean context.
- Ethical, practical, legal, political, and social implications of AI development and deployment in Korea.
- Al applications in music, arts, communication, history, language, education, healthcare, engineering, science, business, economics, tourism, law, public policy, government, politics, athletics, public health, medicine, computer science, mechanical engineering, and other disciplines in Korea.
- Collaborative interdisciplinary approaches in AI research in Korea.
- Creative works such as art and music performances with AI technology in Korea.
- Comparative studies between the US and Korea.
- Systematic literature analysis of AI topics and disciplines in Korea.
- Meta-analysis of AI studies on Korea and its global impact.
- Empirical research with human subject data in AI and Korea.
- Content analysis of big data in Al and Korea.

- Submit your study by August 1, 2025, in pdf format to <u>seok.kang@utsa.edu</u>.
- Include author information on the title page.
- The committee will select **THREE** papers for presentation and announce it in **September 2025**.
- Travel expenses up to \$1,000 per attendee will be supported for the **three students**.
- Selected students must create a digital poster and send the poster file to Seok Kang (seok.kang@utsa.edu) by December 31, 2025.
